A Word From Your Agent...

Hello Shawnee County 4-H,

As the school year winds down, things are getting busier here at the office with fair preparations! Printed fair books will be available for pick up from your club boxes at the office by mid-May. Keep an eye out for an email from 4-H Online notifying you that they are ready. The deadline to enter fair projects will be July 1, so make sure you mark that date on your calendar! We will not accept late entries, the July 1 deadline is final. You will receive a user guide to FairEntry when entries open. Lastly, please, if you have questions about your entries, contact us before the July 1 deadline so we can help you!

We are adding an opportunity for older youth! A group of 4-Hers came to the planning meeting on April 11th and determined that there is a need for a group to promote 4-H, host regular fun community building activities, and take the lead on county-wide service projects. This will be open to all 4-Hers who are 12 as of Jan. 1st of the current year, are in at least their 3rd year of 4-H, and have attended at least 1/3 of their club's meetings in the last year. There will be another planning meeting on June 13th at 6 pm, before the events council meeting that anyone who is interested in joining is invited to! We will be finalizing the structure of the group and planning a kickoff activity for sometime in August.

IMPORTANT: Update to County Fair Livestock Sale

The Shawnee County Fair Board has recently voted to change the format for the Premium Auction at the County Fair. 4-Hers will now be able to select from two sales plans when they complete their "Intent to Sell" form:


- Plan 1: Premium + Market Price. This means the 4-Her will auction the animal for a premium price, then the animal will be sold to a buyer at market price to be butchered. Market price animals will be loaded onto a trailer at the end of the fair to be taken to the locker of the buyer's choice. 4-Her will receive both the premium and the market price for the sale of this animal.
- Plan 2: Premium Only: The 4-Her will auction the animal for a premium price, and the animal will not be offered to a market buyer. The 4-Her will then take the animal home, and will be able to continue to show the animal at state shows if they desire. 4-Her will only receive a premium payment, but will get to keep the animal.

Intent to Sell forms will be due 30 minutes following the Beef show at the fair. You will identify the animal and the sales plan you would like to follow at that time, and buyers will be informed in the sale program and by the auctioneer.

IMPORTANT!

4-H Online Animal Update

ALL species of animals are now able to register animals in 4-H Online. As you know, when you add animal entries to FairEntry, you then have to create an animal before completing the entry. Listing them in 4-H Online will allow us to sync the two systems and give you a list of existing animals to choose from in FairEntry when it comes time to enter fair exhibits. This is not required for 2024, but we would encourage you to give it a try and let us know what you think of the process. 

Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) is a new national, multispecies youth livestock quality assurance program. It is open to youth 7-21 years of age and focuses on food safety, animal well-being, and character development. For further details, YQCA Training please contact Grace Wiens (wiensg@ksu.edu) or Abigail Gettinger (agettinger@ksu.edu) or visit the program website, yqcaprogram.org. **YQCA Training is a requirement in order to be able to sell an animal at the county fair!**

All those wishing to attend a future YQCA Instructor-Led Training, please register at yqcaprogram.org BEFORE attending the training. YQCA Training is still required for all Shawnee County Livestock Exhibitors 4-H Age 7-18 (including Meat Rabbits & Broiler Meat Chickens) and State Livestock Shows; Kansas State Fair & Kansas Junior Livestock Show (KJLS).
